MINUTES FOR THE 2nd TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING

Meeting in Kuressaare, Estonia.

6th- 7th September 2019

Between 6^{th} and 7^{th} september partners met for the 2^{nd} Transnational Meeting of the MOVE-ON! Project.



According the Application Form, the proposes of the second transnational project meeting were discussed as follows:

1) Evaluate the progress of the project in all its aspects:

Budget/time/implementation

There are no news concerning the budget, but coordinating institution, CFPIMM, summarized and clarify the payments made so far and the next one, after the portuguese agency evaluates the intermedial report.

Also was explained to the Poland partner there own payments, because of the change of institution partner.

The partnership analysed the gantt-chart and check if it is being accomplished on time.

The Hungarian partner will send the Report on Women aged over 50 and Adult Educators-needs and expectations, activity A4, until the end of september.

Quality

All evaluations made so far must be part of the Quality Plan: Meetings, $\mathbf{1}^{\mathsf{st}}$ LTTA, activities, etc.

Partners evaluated the 12 months Project on a questionnaire (anexe).

As expected, the partners have a clear understanding of the division of tasks and responsibilities, the timing and the procedures; the procedures described in the quality plan are put into practice; there is a good communication and exchange of information between partners; there is an interesting exchange of skills and ideas among the Partners; the team has a clear and shared understanding of the project rationale, short and long-term objectives; partners are involved of skills with the activities and have good adherence to the work plan.

Whith all project evaluations, partners can define some indicators or other instruments to follow the progress of the Project.

Partnership are aware that Monitorizing System must be done until the end of november.

Partners checked *Risk Managment Plan*. There is no need to make changes on it.

<u>Dissemination and Exploitation Plan</u>

The coordinating institution, CFPIMM, warned to the importance of all partners disseminate the Project in all partners' countries and save evidences to attach to the project report.

Partners will send all the dissemination's activities made in each country to all partners.

Also, all partners will send to Lituanian partner their evidences until the end of september.

Partners suggested that should have one administrator by country.

2) Sharing all the experiences and good practices undertaken (Leaners and Educators) since the LTTA in Portugal.

Partners presented the activities made in each country since the LTTA in Portugal.

Partners shared the experiences and good practices undertaken, presented their difficulties and exchanged ideas to develope activities concerning the 2 target groups: Learners and Educators.

3) Preparing the LTTA in Poland: "Moving on- who can I be"

Partners discussed practical information for the next LTTA, in Poland.

Coordinating partner remembered that the participants (Women and Educators) must have a formal link with partner organization (contract + declaration from partner organization);

Poland partner will propose the date until the end of october.

Concerning the program, topics and work sessions, remembering that all the activities will be oriented for the intervention level - Moving on- who can I be, following the guidelines defined in the application form, partners made a very creative and original

brainstorming to identify some activities that can be performed in the LTTA.



4) Evaluating the meeting

After the formal moment to evaluate the meeting and to delivery the Attendance Certificates, the 2^{nd} TM ended in a very unique event, the street picnic, on the main street of Kuressaare. Thousands of people were gathering to the main streets of Kuressaare to have a picnic with music and entertainment.
